This will show you how to create a customized submission view for quiz so for students so they can see their quiz attempt.



➤ From your course navigation bar, click **“Assessment”** and then **“Quizzes”**:





- Click **“Edit”** from the dropdown menu on the quiz in which you want create the submission view for:

- Click the **“Add Additional View”** button:

Add Additional View

- Enter a **“Name”** for the view
- It is possible to enter a message that the student will see:

- Chose the date and time when the view will be available by clicking in the “Date” boxes:

- It is possible to limit the student to view their quiz submission on the same device in which they took the quiz by clicking the “IP Address” check box:

IP Address

IP Restriction (IPv4) 

- It is also possible to limit the time the student has access to the submission view by clicking the “Limit Duration” and enter the number of minutes:

Limited Duration

Limit the amount of time (in minutes) for which this view is available after the quiz is submitted

- You can choose to show the questions to the students by selecting “Yes” or “No” under the “Show Questions” section

Note: For this example, we will show all the question and the answers as well as their score and class statistics.

- Select “Yes” under “ Show Questions”:


Note: The custom submission view will override the default view.
